Race Numbers.

A condition of entry is that riders use the Official Series Sponsor's number plate. This plate will be issued free to all riders at the first round of the series that they enter and must be used for all subsequent rounds.

Replacement of a lost or "left at home" plate will be at a cost of \$15 to the rider.

Allocation of race numbers for Junior and Elite Classes will respect the assigned UCI BMX Permanent Career Numbers.

Transponders.

Where the race organiser provides/hires transponders for electronic lap timing, it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike. Transponders must be returned to the race organiser at the conclusion of the event and failure to do so will incur a cost to the rider of \$150 plus costs.

Prize Money.

Probikx Prize Pool for each round is \$3000 with the amount for each class determined by entry numbers (true equity method).

Within each class payment is per UCI schedule published in the UCI financial obligations. i.e. 1st to 8th placing: 40%, 20%, 10%, 8%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 4%.

Chambikx Prize Pool for each round is \$600 for Boys Classes and \$600 for Girls Classes, paid for podium finishes only with the breakdown per BMXA rules section G. 1st - 50%, 2nd -30%, 3rd - 20%.
