BMX Australia will be developing this series and in the future will be looking to implement the framework into a series for the 8, 9 and 10 year old riders.

This series will showcase the best riders from all around Australia, competing at the nationals for the chance to be BMX Australia National Dynamite series champion and encourages the riders to take the step up into the probikx/champbikx series when they are older.

BMX Australia is excited about this initiative rewarding talent at the grass roots level.

OVERVIEW

1. This series is to be run by the states & BMX Australia starting 2010-2011.
2. Each state to nominate the number of rounds that the series will be conducted over i.e. state rounds or regional rounds. Final round state championship.
3. States to notify BMX Australia of the dates and places the rounds will be conducted at.
4. States to keep an up to date record of results from each round.



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5. Riders must compete in every round and state titles to be awarded series winner.
6. Points will be awarded for moto`s and final. 50% for moto`s and 50% for finals.
7. One round to be a double points round, to be determined by states. NOT state titles.
8. At the end of the series the top three place riders in each age and gender class will be eligible to compete at the finally at the national titles on Probikx/Chambikx day.
9. State coaches to be involved preparing the riders for the finals at the nationals.
10. Time trials will determine seeding for riders at nationals.
11. Riders to ride in state shirts.
12. Presentation of national Dynamite series winners to be at the Probikx /Chambikx awards night.
13. States are to organise a profile of each rider for the awards night.
14. All series winners to be given an invitation to the awards night.
15. First place winner to receive a trophy and a prize purse.
16. A state team trophy could be awarded as well.
