Organisation of Greener Cycling Events

ECOBMX targets all organisers of BMX events at local, regional and National events.

Management of the Venue & the Event

- Avoid excessive use of energy when it comes to lighting, heating and air conditioning.
- Ensure efficient management of waste, rubbish bins, compost & recycling.
- Implement a no smoking policy in all areas of the event.
- Minimise water wastage when watering tracks.
- Reduce waste from rider registration bags
- Reduce paper used for entry flyers, official sheets & results and maximise recycling of paper that has to be used at events.
- Develop systems-
 - to email flyers more efficiently
 - improve & encourage online nominations
 - to expand use of points cafes for results
 - for a website to deliver results via WiFi

Catering at events

- Reduce waste from food and drink packaging
- Minimise food waste and maximise composting and recycling
- Reduce the ecological impact of food production
- Where possible use tap water instead of bottle water
- Where possible, promote and give preference to healthy food of high quality for all refreshments provided at your Event
- Use catering services proposed in your area
